### New Berm Rule Now In Effect

Recognizing the need for a change, the Board of Directors has implemented a new Berm Rule effective August 7, 2016.

- This new Berm Rule supersedes and eliminates any assessment of infraction levied prior to August 7, 2016. In other words, it's a new beginning.
- This Berm Rule applies to all disciplines and forms of shooting activity conducted on the Ricochet Junction Range, be it by club sanction and permission or by property owner permission.
- The objective of the New Rule remains the same as that of the Rule being replaced:
  - For Safety and Liability Concerns, NO Rifle or Pistol Rounds of any Caliber Be Fired Over the Berm.
- The Rule Reads as Follows:
  - First Occurrence
    - Shooter receives a Match Disqualification (MDQ)
    - Shooter is required to attend Firearms Safety & Handling training before being allowed to shoot at Ricochet Junction Range.
      - Does not impact membership status or preclude participation in club functions or activities.
  - Second Occurrence
    - Shooter receives a Match Disqualification (MDQ)
    - Shooter is required to attend Firearms Safety & Handling training before being allowed to shoot at Ricochet Junction Range.
    - Shooter is suspended from shooting at Ricochet Junction Range for a period of sixty (60) days.
      - Does not impact membership status or preclude participation in club functions or activities.

- Third Occurrence
  - Shooter is permanently banned from shooting at Ricochet Junction Range.
    - Does not impact membership status or preclude participation in club functions or activities.

### **Monthly Match Alibi**

Forget to take your gun to the stage, not bring enough ammo, have your gun jam or something else like a “Senior Moment” happen? If that ever happens to you, take note, you might have an alibi for a “do over”.

The Board of Directors voted to allow one (1) Alibi per shooter per match for reasons OTHER THAN SAFETY INFRACTIONS, effective August 7, 2016.

### **SDQ Scoring**

To achieve uniformity with other clubs, scoring of a Stage Disqualification (SDQ) will be:

The product of the total number of shots required for completion of the stage, multiplied by 5, plus 30 seconds.
