Bankers Report

- The Bankers Report presented by Armstrong Rosie, aka Linda Cleave
 - Included a boarded budget report depicting detailed 2016 Revenue (excluding the revenue generated by Ambush at Ricochet Junction 2016) vs Expenditures, resulting in a negative balance of \$2726.91.
 - Armstrong Rosie concluded her report explaining that without some additional revenue generating endeavor, such as the Annual Match or other undertaking, the club cannot support itself on income generated by Membership Dues and Monthly Match Fees alone.
