- **Harry Tracy Handgun Target Side Match by Ranger Six**

The October Match at **Ricochet Junction** included a side match, *The Harry Tracy Handgun Target Shoot*. This was a dry run to prepare for the *Hickok Handgun Trophy* which will be offered as a side match at the **2018 Annual Ambush at Ricochet Junction**. A custom made, 24 inch round target, placed at the far end of Bay 2, was engaged by all the shooters present on Saturday & Sunday. Each shooter made one pistol shot, one handed, unsupported and bullet placement was confirmed by a spotter. Of 20 rounds sent down range, 7 hit the target. The shooters who hit the target placed their alias next to their bullet hole. With steely determination and a steady hand, **A.T. McGee** put his bullet closest to the target center, which allowed him to be awarded the target and accompanying framed legend which will be proudly displayed at **Ricochet Junction**.

Harry Tracy
23 October 1875 - 6 August 1902

Tracy was an outlaw in the Old West, and is said to have run with Butch Cassidy and the Hole in the Wall Gang. Most of his crimes revolved later 1901. Tracy was captured, convicted and incarcerated at the Oregon State Penitentiary. In June of 1902 he escaped, during which he killed 3 correction officers as well as 2 cowboys. His claim to infamy is the size and scope of the manhunt and the extensive media coverage during the time he evaded capture. For a month he took refuge in the Seaside, Washington. On 3 July, 1902 Tracy killed 2 more peace officers in Richland, Washington. On 6 August, 1902, in Clifton, Washington, Tracy was cornered and managed to evade the posse and took cover in a field, where he soon became surrounded. Eventually Tracy committed suicide to avoid capture. Tracy's gun can be found on display at the White River Valley Museum in Auburn, Washington.
