Harry Tracy Handgun Target Side Match by Ranger Six

The October Match at Ricochet Junction included a side match, *The Harry Tracy Handgun Target Shoot*. This was a dry run to prepare for the *Hickok Handgun Trophy* which will be offered as a side match at the 2018 Annual Ambush at Ricochet Junction. A custom made, 24 inch round target, placed at the far end of Bay 2, was engaged by all the shooters present on Saturday & Sunday. Each shooter made one pistol shot, one handed, unsupported and bullet placement was confirmed by a spotter. Of 20 rounds sent down range, 7 hit the target. The shooters who hit the target placed their alias next to their bullet hole. With steely determination and a steady hand, A.T. McGee put his bullet closest to the target center, which allowed him to be awarded the target and accompanying framed legend which will be proudly displayed at Ricochet Junction.
