Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Ranger Six

Some changes to CAS Shooter's Handbook January 2019

"All shotgun knockdown targets may be reengaged until down."

Addition of word shotgun.

Revolvers are returned to leather (holstered in a safe condition) at the conclusion of the shooting string." Change in punctuation.

Revolver and rifle ammunition "May not be jacketed, semi-jacked, plated or gas checked." Removal of words copper washed.

"All firearms taken to the firing line must be checked, whether or not they were used."

Substitution of word *firearm* for *revolvers*.

"Use of ammo from cartridge loops mounted on a firearms stock or forearm is not allowed" Addition of whole sentence.
