### **Ladies Only Shooting Society Program Cancelled**

*Granny Gunsmoke* announced the *Ladies Only Shooting Society* is being discontinued due to the lack of attendance coupled with personal cost of liability insurance, rendering the program a no longer viable undertaking.

### **NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program (2<sup>ND</sup> Saturday of each month)**

The NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program will continue as long as participant interest and attendance remain strong enough to support the program. This program, as was the *Ladies Only Shooting Society*, is sanctioned by the club for the diversified use of the **Ricochet Junction Range** for the conductance of a structured Shooting Sport program not affiliated with the Northeast Washington Regulators or Cowboy Action Shooting. Such programs are submitted as a Business Plan to the Board of Directors, must be self-supporting and voluntarily conducted by club members qualified by certification to do so. If found to be of merit and not in conflict with the Bi-laws, Articles of Incorporation, Lease Agreement or Liability Insurance covenants, the proposal is forwarded for final approval by vote of Northeast Washington Regulators membership. The purpose of offering such programs is to promote Shooting Sports, introduce the Northeast Washington Regulators to our community, and to achieve diversified use of the **Ricochet Junction Range**. Net proceeds generated from such programs, are submitted for deposit into the Northeast Washington Regulators account.

Thirteen Shooters joined in Saturday to have a go at **A.T. McGee's** scenario offerings with 15 joining in Sunday to posse-up and test their skill with **Del Monte's** fun and challenging scenarios.

- Any SASS legal: 12 ga. Shotgun and Rifle Chambered in a Handgun Caliber
- Any Centerfire Handgun: Semi-Auto or Revolver (Speed Loaders Allowed)
- Ammunition: Bullets MUST be Cast Lead. No POWER FACTOR Requirements
- Shooters may Borrow MAGS, Reload on Line or Load 10. Shooters loading 10 are NOT ELIGIBLE to win in Category or Overall.

The **OPEN** category has also been added for the **Wild Bunch Match** included in the itinerary of **AMBUSH** at **RICOCHET JUNCTION 2017**.
