Interested in experiencing **Wild Bunch Action Shooting** but do not have all the SASS required equipment? An **OPEN** category has been added for the Monthly Matches which allows participation with less stringent firearm requirements.

- Any SASS legal: 12 ga. Shotgun and Rifle Chambered in a Handgun Caliber
- Any Centerfire Handgun: Semi-Auto or Revolver (Speed Loaders Allowed)
- Ammunition: Bullets MUST be Cast Lead. No POWER FACTOR Requirements
- Shooters may Borrow MAGS, Reload on Line or Load 10. Shooters loading 10 are NOT ELIGIBLE to win in Category or Overall.
