Buckaroo & Buckarette are age based categories for Cowboy shooters age 13 & under. They provide provisions for younger shooters to be able to participate in CAS. They must use firearms that meet the external standards, but may be chambered in .22 LR for rifle & pistol and .410, 28 or 32 gauge for shotguns.

Did You Know (Buckaroo & Buckarette continued)

Knockdown targets must be engaged & hit, but do not need to fall. An alternative target must be provided for all aerial shotgun targets. If centerfire ammunition is used, it must meet all centerfire power factor and velocity requirements. (Clarification made in January 2019 edition of Shooter's Hand Book, under Stage Conventions.)
