Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Ranger Six

Some changes to CAS Shooter's Handbook January 2019

"All <u>shotgun</u> knockdown targets may be reengaged until down."
Addition of word shotgun.
Revolvers are returned to leather (holstered in a safe condition)
at the conclusion of the shooting string." Change in punctuation.
Revolver and rifle ammunition "May not be jacketed, semi-jacked, plated or gas checked." Removal of words <u>copper washed.</u>
"All <u>firearms</u> taken to the firing line must be checked, whether or not they were used." Substitution of word *firearm* for *revolvers*.

<u>"Use of ammo from cartridge loops mounted on a firearms stock or forearm is not allowed</u>" Addition of whole sentence.
