From the 2019 Shooter's Handbook

"If the rifle is the last firearm used (**NOT** recommended), it must be cleared prior to it leaving the shooter's hand(s) at the unloading area."

"The minimum standard for center-fire ammunition used in all smokeless categories no velocity may be less than 400 fps."

"The maximum velocities are 1000 fps for revolvers and 1400 fps for rifles."

Revolver Cylinder Pins "The cylinder pin may be shortened."
