Did You Know?

Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Ranger Six

While a denim predecessor known as dungaree has been produced in India for hundreds of years, denim itself was first produced in the French city of Nimes. Levi Strauss founded his clothing company in 1853 and sold denim material. Jacob Davis, a taylor in Nevada, purchased denim wholesale from Levi Strauss & Co. and was the first to use copper rivets at the stress points to make heavy duty work pants for miners and cowboys.

In 1873, a partnership was formed on Davis's design with financial backing coming from Strauss. For "Blue Jeans" to be period correct for CAS, they must use a button fly and no belt loops. Belts and belt loops were not commonly seen until the 1920's.
