Did You Know?

Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Ranger Six

The Side by Side Shotgun, Part 1

Getting the most bang for your buck, no pun intended, requires the SXS to be worked over before it's ready for a Cowboy Match. Main springs and top lever spring may need to be replaced or lightened. Removal of the safety connector rod can be done to disable the automatic safety (it can be placed back if you want to have the automatic feature again). If the action does not open far enough for quick loading, the cocking cams can be replaced with aftermarket modified cocking cams. The chambers can be polished and the mouth of the chambers beveled to allow for quicker loading. From the factory, double triggers have the rear trigger off set to the left. This works well for a left hander as the trigger finger slides off the front trigger onto the rear trigger. For a right hander to have the same advantage, reverse the triggers. The extractor pin and the channel it travels in needs to be polished. All bearing points and the locking lugs on the bottom of the receiver need to be polished as well. The top lever can be bent (re-profiled) to shorten the travel time, but per SASS regulations, only 1/2 inch or less from the center of the tang to the outside of the lever.
