### Did You Know?

#### Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Ranger Six

#### The Side by Side Shotgun Part 2

To get consistent removal of hulls from a SxS, the chambers must be as smooth (polished with steel wool around a brass brush and spun in an electric hand drill) and clean as possible. Use a mop or brush to clean after 1 or 2 stages. Loaded shells that are dropped get put aside until cleaned again. Reloads require special attention. Clean in warm water & liquid dish soap (Dawn works well). Any hull that is out of round gets used in practice, in a pump or is discarded. A stepped on hull may appear round when reloaded, but will return to out of round status once fired and will likely stick in chamber. Rumor has it smooth sided hulls shuck better than ribbed ones. Remington STS & Nitro hulls are a few thousands smaller in diameter than Winchester AA ones. Foreign shotgun primers (like RIO) are a few thousands larger than ones produced in the USA. They work well, but will stretch the primer pocket making the primer pocket too large for use with domestic primers in subsequent loadings.
