Timer Operator Tips Part 1

Notes from TO class given by Shamrock Sadie

The TO (Timer Operator) is responsible for safe conduct of the stage and safely assisting the shooter through the course of fire. When stage is clear, targets set, spotters are in position, and it is safe to do so, the TO will call the next shooter to the line (Shooters should wait to be called by the TO).

The TO conducts a visual inspection to include; Hammer on rifle, Glasses & Ear Protection, Enough shotgun shells, SG belt position, Pistols, Holsters in the correct position, Category clothing and Reloads in the correct place.

Cowboy Action Shooting fun happens on the first week-end (Saturday & Sunday) of the month at Ricochet Junction. Ranger Six will be providing scenarios for September 5 & 6 so don't miss out on the good time to be had by all.
