Timer Operator Tips Part 3

Notes from TO class given by Shamrock Sadie

Before the TO starts the timer, check to ensure the spotters are behind the 180 of the shooter. Best if spotters are spread out and in the virtual line behind the TO. Make sure timer is turned on. Wait for shooter to say line to indicate shooter is ready. Once line is given, announce "Shooter is ready; stand by". Give a short pause, 1-3 seconds and start the timer. Be consistent in the length of the pause for all shooters. Hold timer behind the shooter's head so they can hear the beep, don't touch the hat and stay out of their peripheral vision. Ensure timer is working, check recording of the first shot.
