Timer Operator Tips Part 4

Notes from TO class given by Shamrock Sadie

The TO should try to anticipate the shooter's movement. Stay within arm's length of the competitor until the stage is finished; but not so close as to impede the shooter. Make every effort to safely assist the shooter through the course of fire by coaching when required or requested.

Watch the muzzle of the firearm. Watch the hammer on the rifle. Check for last round ejecting out of long guns. Observe rifle reloads. Watch the restaging of long guns and holstering of pistols. Listen for squibs. Count shots, **NOT MISSES**.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

Territorial Governor Ranger 6 shared with the Board of Directors some changes being discussed, and in some cases enacted, by other SASS clubs due to the shortages of ammunition and reloading components. For monthly shoots these include :

- Lower ammo requirements for scenarios
- Allowance of any firearm including semi-autos centerfire or rimfire.
- Centerfire ammo must be of pistol caliber with projectiles of type and velocity which meet steel target design and safety requirements.

The North-East Washington Regulators Board of Directors is seeking Membership Input regarding concerns, approval or other avenues of approach before further consideration is given to this matter.
