Timer Operator Tips Part 5

Notes from TO class given by Shamrock Sadie

Once the last shot of the stage is fired, the TO should immediately cover the timer's microphone. Then announce the stage time to the shooter in a loud, clear voice. Poll the 3 spotters to determine misses and penalties, then call the results to the score keeper and the competitor in a loud, clear voice.

After the guns are retrieved, declare the Range clear. Convey time to the score keeper, then show the score keeper the time. Watch the score keeper write down the time and any penalties. If there is a need for a discussion that would take more than a few moments, consider passing off the timer to a new TO, and move the discussion to well behind the firing line.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

Responding to the Board of Directors seeking member input, a motion was made to introduce the use of an *OPEN* category for the monthly matches. The said motion was entertained, voted on and passed by the Board. The use of this category will remain available until the Board determines it is no longer warranted.

The *OPEN* category will be permitted starting with the April Monthly Matches however shooters doing so will not be eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber(No Magnum)
 - All bullets must be lead only
 - .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios
 - May be abbreviated
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
 - Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
