Did You Know?

Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Territorial Governor Ranger Six HATS

Part 2

Something to consider is what is a cowboy hat? Many folks might think of the iconic cowboy hat as the Stetson. John Stetson began the Stetson Hat Company in 1865 and presented the "Boss of the Plains" hat to the Old West and this style is still in production. By looking at photographs of the cowboy era, many cowboys are seen wearing other types of headgear. The Derby, or sometimes called the Bowler, was a very commonly seen style and was often preferred because the hat stayed on in windy conditions. Wool caps, sombreros and military hats left over from the Civil War also are seen in old pictures.

Have you ever wondered what a 10 Gallon hat is? The 10 Gallon hat gets its name from the Spanish word "Galon", not because it could hold 10 gallons of water. Galon means braid and many Spanish hats had multiple braids on it. One with 10 braids was a 10 Galon hat.

Cowboy custom is to turn the hat upside down when placing on a flat surface. This allows the hat to air out and prevents the rolled or up-turned brim to flatten. Another reason is that cowboy superstition says that the cowboy's luck will run out of the hat if placed right side up, and never ever place a hat on a bed.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

The *OPEN* category will be permitted for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - o Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber (No Magnum)
 - o All bullets must be lead only
 - o .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
