Did You Know?

Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Territorial Governor Ranger Six

The following deals with what to do if a shooter comes to the line not wearing safety glasses, courtesy of Pale Wolf Brunelle.

1) Shooter must stop (or be stopped) immediately due to the seriousness of the safety issue involved. This would not constitute "RO impeding / interference" in handling a shooter's equipment failure; therefore, there would be no grounds for a restart / reshoot. Precedent exists regarding the handling of suspected "squib" during stage engagement.

2) If the shooter is able to remedy the issue safely, She/he may continue the stage after resolution. An RO should be allowed to "safely assist" the shooter in this case (e.g. retrieve & return safety glasses to the shooter if the shooter has a cocked firearm in hand).

3) If the shooter is unable to safely resolve the situation (e.g. glasses are broken or end up ahead of an active firing line), the shooter would receive a DNF due to inability to continue and complete the stage.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

The *OPEN* category will be permitted for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber (No Magnum)
 - All bullets must be lead only
 - .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
