#### Winter Rules Update Effective December 4

In accordance with the Board of Directors determination: Monthly matches will be cancelled if the forecasted temperature is 25 degrees F or lower. All other remaining Winter Rules provisions remain unchanged.

Cold weather is here and being a warm, comfortable and safe shooter is more important than styling in your best cowboy garb. So dress warm, stage your six-guns if your hands are cold, slow down a bit to be safe and have fun.

To be totally on the safe side, if the forecasted range temperature for Ricochet Junction on match days is 25 degrees F or lower the match will be cancelled. If such is the case, notice will be given via e-mail to all North-East Washington Regulators & Friends

To alleviate the effort of finding all of your rifle brass buried in the snow, and not to be construed with shooting in the OPEN class, lever or pump rimfire rifles chambered in 22LR may be used in lieu of center fire cowboy action rifles for monthly matches.

## Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

The *OPEN* category will be permitted for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
  - o Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
  - o Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
  - o Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
  - Any type of firearm may be used.
  - Must be standard pistol caliber(No Magnum)
  - o All bullets must be lead only
  - o .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated
  - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2
    by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun
    Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
  - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
