Tidbits to ponder courtesy of Territorial Governor Ranger Six
SASS Sanctioned Matches
Part 5

For a Championship Match the club agrees to the following which are beyond what is required for a local level match:

- 1 - Provide single card recognition as "SASS Presents " before "Match Title" and "The SASS "location" Cowboy Action Shooting Championship" after "Match Title" in all advertising, printed materials, event program cover, shooters program and awards presentations.
- 2 - Print the "SASS Sanctioned Marshal" logo in every instance the "Match Title" is used as outlined in # 1.
- 3 - Provide display space for SASS banners.
- 4 - Event Program advertising: One black and white full page on inside front cover, dedicated to SASS.
- 5 - 10' x 10' SASS vendor display space.
- 6 - Two passes to the event, Hospitality Tent, and all social functions.
- 7 - Submit appropriate sanctioning fees to SASS within 30 days of completion of event. (\$5.00 per shooter @ state level, \$7.00 at regional and ? for higher levels, with a \$100.00 minimum sanctioning fee).

In addition, each regional match must offer free registration for all champions at the state level within that region and so forth up the line.

NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program (MQP)

The 2022 NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program (MQP) is underway and the next session is Saturday, November 19, weather permitting.

In the October session shooting *Pistol Qualification*, Richard Payette completed the Sharp Shooter. Gary Farris completed the Expert course of fire and Micky Payette is working toward completion of the Expert course of fire.

Shooting the *Tactical Rifle Qualification*, Gary Farris completed the Pro Marksman, Marksman and Sharpshooter courses of fire.

The November 19 session will conclude the 2022 NRA MQP.

The 2023 NRA MQP is scheduled to commence Saturday May 20 and sessions will continue monthly on the 3rd Saturday at the North-East Washington Regulators' Ricochet Junction Range. Start time is 9:00 A.M.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

The **OPEN** category will be permitted for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the **OPEN** Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber(No Magnum)
 - All bullets must be lead only
 - .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
