Winter Range Schedule

Movie Lines

In the movie Tombstone, Doc Holliday says to Johnny Ringo "I'm your Huckleberry" in a couple of scenes. This never made sense to me, it does not relate to anything. I have recently learned that in the 1800's the handle on a coffin was called a huckle, and the person carrying the casket was called a bearer. So, what we call a pall bearer today was called a huckle bearer back in the old west. I think Val Kilmer might have flubbed his line and said huckleberry instead of huckle bearer, which would make sense in that Doc was predicting that he would soon be Ringo's pall bearer. Another term used by Doc is Daisy. This was an old 19th century southern slang term meaning "better". When Doc lays down his cards in a poker game, he calls it a Daisy (the better hand). When the last cowboy in the shootout at the OK corral says to Doc that he is gonna kill him, Doc responds "You're a Daisy if you do" meaning the cowboy would then be the better man. There are also other interpretations of these terms floating around out there.

In many movies the line "Lord (or God) willing and the creek don't rise" implies that something good will happen if all goes well.

When John Wayne said this line I wonder exactly what he meant because "creek don't rise" can be interpreted two ways. The first would imply the rising water would prevent passage over the flooded creek. A second explanation would involve the 19 tribal groups of American Indians in the 1800's who joined together and formed the Creek Confederacy, which fought wars against the white settlers. This second meaning would have indicated all would go well if the Creek Indians did not rise up and start another battle or war.

Considerations Concerning Ammo Shortage

The *OPEN* category will be permitted for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category. *Open* Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - o Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber(No Magnum)
 - o All bullets must be lead only
 - o .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2
 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun
 Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
