#### Did You Know?

The NEW Regulators have recently had experiences concerning. DNF's (Did Not Finish) which has led to a need for clarification.

For the past several years DNF has been explained in the scoring section of the SASS Shooter's Handbook. No mention of DNF is found in the Match DQ section (Shooter's Handbook, Version 27.4, Jan 2023 edition) or earlier. DNF is also not mentioned in the RO 1 Handbook, Version 28.4, May 2023, nor the RO 2 Handbook, Version 25.2, Jan 2023.

The MDQ section in the latest Shooter's Handbook, Jan 2023, runs from page 22 - 24. The next section, Scoring, states on page 24 "The score for a DNF ... is the same as a SDQ penalty the maximum allowed time for that stage.". Page 25 states "Two SDQ/DNF's (or one of each) in the same match results MDQ.".

Many of The NEW Regulators do not think someone should be penalized for a DNF and have suggested removing DNF stages from the list of things resulting in a MDQ for regular monthly matches. The Match Director and the Board will address the status of DNF's for upcoming annual matches at some time in the future.

### Open Category

The **OPEN** category is offered as an alternative for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but not eligible to win match or win in any category. Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
  - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
  - o Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
  - o Targets are required to be hit but not fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
  - o Any type of firearm may be used.
  - Must be standard pistol caliber (No Magnum)
  - o All centerfire bullets must be cast lead. No Jacketed Ammunition.
  - o .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated.
  - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed however shooter may use a different firearm.
  - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
