The SASS Shooters Handbook states "All shooters must be in costume... and all clothing and equipment must be worn appropriately and how it was intended." Footwear is not spelled out but is implied that it should be of the cowboy era. Some outlawed items include athletic shoes or combat boots, and those made of nylon, plastic or using Velcro accourrements. Logos are also outlawed. There is nothing that addresses wearing sandals or shooting in bare feet.

For folks shooting in the classic cowboy/girl category, boots are required and must be of traditional design with non-grip soles. Moccasins are not allowed in this category. Boots are also required for B-Western shooters and must be of traditional design and embellished with fancy stitching, multi-color fancy designs, conchos or spots. Soles also must be of a non-grip design. Lace up boots and moccasins are not allowed.

Also, just in case it slipped your mind, it's time to renew your membership. The one thing not touched by inflation, the 1^{st} Adult of the household is still only \$40.00 and the second, \$30.00. Youngsters 16 and under remain \$10.00.



Open Category

The **OPEN** category is offered as an alternative for Monthly Matches. Shooting in the *OPEN* Category will be fun but participants are not eligible to win match or win in any category.

Open Category will allow the following:

- Shotgun
 - Any type of shotgun 12 gauge or smaller
 - o Shot requirement will remain #4 Birdshot or smaller.
 - o Targets are required to be hit but not to fall.
- Rifle and Pistol
 - Any type of firearm may be used.
 - Must be standard pistol caliber (No Magnum)
 - o All centerfire bullets must be of cast lead. No Jacketed Ammunition.
 - o .22 Rimfire ammunition of Standard Velocity is permitted.
- Scenarios may be abbreviated.
 - Example: If round count is 10-10 & 4. Shooter may elect to shoot 5-5 & 2 by shooting the first 5 Rifle, the first 5 Pistol and the first 2 Shotgun Targets.
- Target Order Must Be Followed, however shooter may use a different firearm.
 - Example: Shooter only has a .22 Rifle. Shooter would engage all Rifle, Pistol, and Shotgun Targets with his/her Rifle.
