Have you ever considered that having a CAS match involves more than just showing up and slinging lead down-range?

Before a NEW Regulators monthly match some work is done to get ready. Granny Gunsmoke cleans off the tables and counter surfaces and prepares coffee and hot water for the next morning. She also tidies up each restroom and gets the registration forms & score sheets ready. Guess who also does the mowing of the grass on the range? Covada is on call for any range or target repairs and keeps the road in shape as well.

A.T. picks up bakery goodies on his drive to the range for our enjoyment (remember, the mid-morning snack is the most important snack of the day). Someone has written stages and set up targets, but the rifle racks and carpets must be put out and the timer and spotter's sticks rounded up. Depending on the weather, ice and water bottles are set out on the range.

During the match we should all consider that CAS is really a team sport consisting of a Shooter, TO, 3 Spotters and a Safety officer at the Unloading Table, plus a Score keeper and that these duties need to be rotated around so we can all enjoy the match.

Once the last shot is sent downrange and the fun is over, there are still things that need to be done. Rifle racks & carpets need to be put away, trash picked up, water bottles returned. The registration form and fees collected are turned in to Rosie so the paperwork and banking can be done, and the Governor gets his share (yes, we are taxed by the state). A.T. compiles the scores then sends them out to get posted on the WEB site and Yeti gets them out on social media. The scores are also written up in the monthly newsletter which A.T. writes.

Lots of behind-the-scenes work is done so we can all enjoy our cowboy shooting.

To paraphrase JFK: Ask not what the NEW Regulators can do for you, but rather what can you do for the NEW Regulators!
