DID YOU KNOW?

While perusing the January 2024 Shooter's Handbook, I found some information that corrected some misconceptions I had regarding penalties.

I had heard that the penalty for firing more rounds than necessary was only the extra time it took to shoot the extra rounds. Under procedural infractions it is written "Firing more rounds than specified in the stage instructions." (p.21-22).

I was also under the impression that if someone did not have enough ammunition and was given some, those rounds were counted as misses. However, another procedural infraction listed is "Use of illegally acquired ammunition". (p.21). "Illegally acquired ammunition is any ammunition not carried to the line and/or staged by the shooter..." (p.27).

In the event a shooter's holsters fell from their waist I had been told that if the pistol/s remained in the holster/s it was a no call, but if the pistol/s left the holster/s then the penalty was determined by if the pistol/s were loaded or not. In the Glossary of Terms, "Dropped firearm - a firearm that has left the shooter's control and comes to rest at a location or position other than where it was intended" (p.42). Under Stage DQ it states, "Any dropped unloaded firearm on the firing line." (p.22) and under Match DQ it states, "Dropping a loaded firearm." (p.23).

One of the most incorrectly called penalty is the situation where pistol targets are shot with the rifle, and/or rifle targets are shot with the pistol/s. Often the penalty called is a procedural, however under the penalties overview, 5-second penalties, "Each target hit with an incorrect firearm-either intentionally or by mistake." (p.21). So, if the TO or RO's realizes that targets are being engaged with the wrong gun, tell the shooter to help minimize the number of 5 second penalties.



Speed Steel

Speed Steel is open to the public and monthly matches are held on the 3rd Sunday of each month. The program has expanded the use of firearms to include centerfire pistols and PC Carbines with cast lead ammunition. The next match will be Sunday, November 17(weather permitting).


