## Did You Know?

Have you ever seen one of the old cowboy westerns, like a silent movie with Tom
Mix, where the cowboy is on horseback and firing his 6 shooter? He places his
revolver over and behind his shoulder and then flings it back to a normal position
in an out stretched hand and then fires. It always seemed to me like he was
throwing the bullet out of the barrel.

There actually is a reason the cowboy shot this way. The first generation of Colt 6 shooters had a pretty stiff hammer spring and were difficult to cock the hammer duelist style with just a thumb. When the riding cowboy threw his revolver forward from behind his shoulder, it aided in the cocking of the gun. Since many of the first cowboy actors had been real cowboys, they knew the trick to making cocking the hammers easier by throwing it over the shoulder.

# Speed Steel

Program fees per session: Club Members = \$10.00, Non-Members = \$15.00 This program is conducted by NRA certified Range Safety Officers and fees include Targets, Program Book, and Achievement Awards.
