Did You Know?

Have you ever considered that without gunpowder we would not be Cowboy shooting? Gunpowder, also commonly known as black powder to distinguish it from modern smokeless powder, is the earliest known chemical explosive. It consists of a mixture of sulfur, charcoal (which is mostly carbon) and potassium nitrate (saltpeter). The sulfur and charcoal act as fuels, while the saltpeter is an oxidizer.

The first confirmed reference to what can be considered gunpowder in China occurred in the 9th century. The invention of gunpowder by Chinese alchemists was likely an accidental byproduct from experiments seeking to create the elixir of life. Because of their similar use, both the original black powder formulation and the smokeless propellant which replaced it are now commonly described as gunpowder.

The combustion products of smokeless powder are mainly gaseous, compared to around 55% of solid products for black powder. In addition, smokeless powder does not leave the thick heavy fouling of hygroscopic material associated with black powder that causes rusting of the barrel. Smokeless powder was invented by Paul Vielle in 1884, and the most common formulations of smokeless powder are based on nitrocellulose. Vielle named his smokeless powder Poudre B (short for Poudre Blanch, white powder, as distinguished from black powder). In 1887, Alfred Noble obtained an English patent for a smokeless gunpowder he called Ballistite, which was patented in the United States in 1891. Nobel is also known for his inventing Dynamite, but he had such misgivings about his invention's contribution to warfare that he went on to create the Nobel Peace Prize to atone for his actions

Speed Steel is open to the public and monthly matches are held on the 3^{rd} Sunday of each month. The program has expanded the use of firearms to include centerfire pistols and PC Carbines with cast lead ammunition.

NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program (MQP)

The NRA Marksmanship Program is a self-paced skill development program open to the public. Qualifications offered: Pistol, Defensive Pistol I, Defensive Pistol II and Rimfire Rifle. Other Qualifications may be available if interest warrants.

Program fees per session: Club Members = \$10.00, Non-Members = \$15.00, 17 years & under= \$5.00.

Participants are required to provide a safe firearm along with ammunition and demonstrate the ability to safely handle and use it. Eye & Ear protection is mandatory. Program sessions are conducted monthly on the 3rd Saturday. Start Time: 9:00 A.M. The next scheduled session is Saturday, July 19, 2025.
