Did You Know?

There have been some questions raised lately regarding the interpretation of SASS rules. (The following references are from the 2025 Shooter's Handbook) Page 16 "Shotguns are always staged open and empty and are loaded on the clock unless the stage begins with the shotgun in the shooter's hands." So, it seems when shotgun starts in hand you can always load it before the buzzer. The general consensus is that it still should be done on the instruction of the TO.

Page 14 "ALL SASS <u>Safety</u> conventions are not negotiable…". Page 14 "The following stage conventions (stage defaults) should be followed in all SASS matches unless otherwise directed in the stage descriptions." There seems to be a difference of opinion in the interpretation of these rules, but as always in disputes, the advantage goes to the shooter. So, as long as the stage instructions do not violate safety conventions the stage writer can alter stage conventions. The issue was, does the shotgun have to be in hands? If stage instructions state shotgun in hand/s, then the shooter can decide which position works best for them.

Another item regards ammunition. Page 28 "Shooters may not start a stage with ammunition in hand(s).". This may be interpreted as being held in hand(s), but it is OK for the fingers to be touching the ammunition.



Speed Steel

Speed Steel is open to the public and monthly matches are held on the 3^{rd} Sunday of each month. The program has expanded the use of firearms to include centerfire pistols and PC Carbines with cast lead ammunition.

NRA Marksmanship Qualification Program (MQP)

The NRA Marksmanship Program is a self-paced skill development program open to the public. Qualifications offered: Pistol, Defensive Pistol I, Defensive Pistol II and Rimfire Rifle. Other Qualifications may be available if interest warrants.

Program fees per session: Club Members = \$10.00, Non-Members = \$15.00, 17 years & under= \$5.00.

Participants are required to provide a safe firearm along with ammunition and demonstrate the ability to safely handle and use it. Eye & Ear protection is mandatory. Program sessions are conducted monthly on the 3rd Saturday. Start Time: 9:00 A.M.
