Did You Know?

Complements of Territorial Governor Ranger Six

Did you know the NEW Regulators have one of the most comprehensive target arrays of any Cowboy clubs around? Rifle and pistol targets include vertical target hangers which allow for more varied target displays, a Texas Star, knock down targets with small bottles, tombstone and pie rack knockdowns. Static target sizes are 16x16 and 24x24 with round, square and triangle shapes plus irregular configurations such as animals, deck of card symbols and cowboys. A new target is the Buffalo on a zip line which runs parallel with the firing line.

The shotgun targets are the most diverse of any club I have ever shot at. Aside from the usual tombstone knockdowns seen everywhere, the New Regulators have snakes shot off a stand or out of a rope circle, and 4-inch diameter pipes also shot off stands, 3 clay pigeon launchers and 1 clay rabbit launcher (for targets that roll along the ground). Our Texas Star has been used as a shotgun target as well as plastic gallon milk bottles. A few shotgun targets are mounted on heavy duty coil springs that jiggle when shot and a couple of pop ups which have launched ice cubes, charcoal briquettes, clay pigeons, and the all-time favorite, pop cans which when shaken well, are very impressive as they explode when hit. Another shotgun target favorite is the downrange door, which is shot open, leading to more targets to engage.
